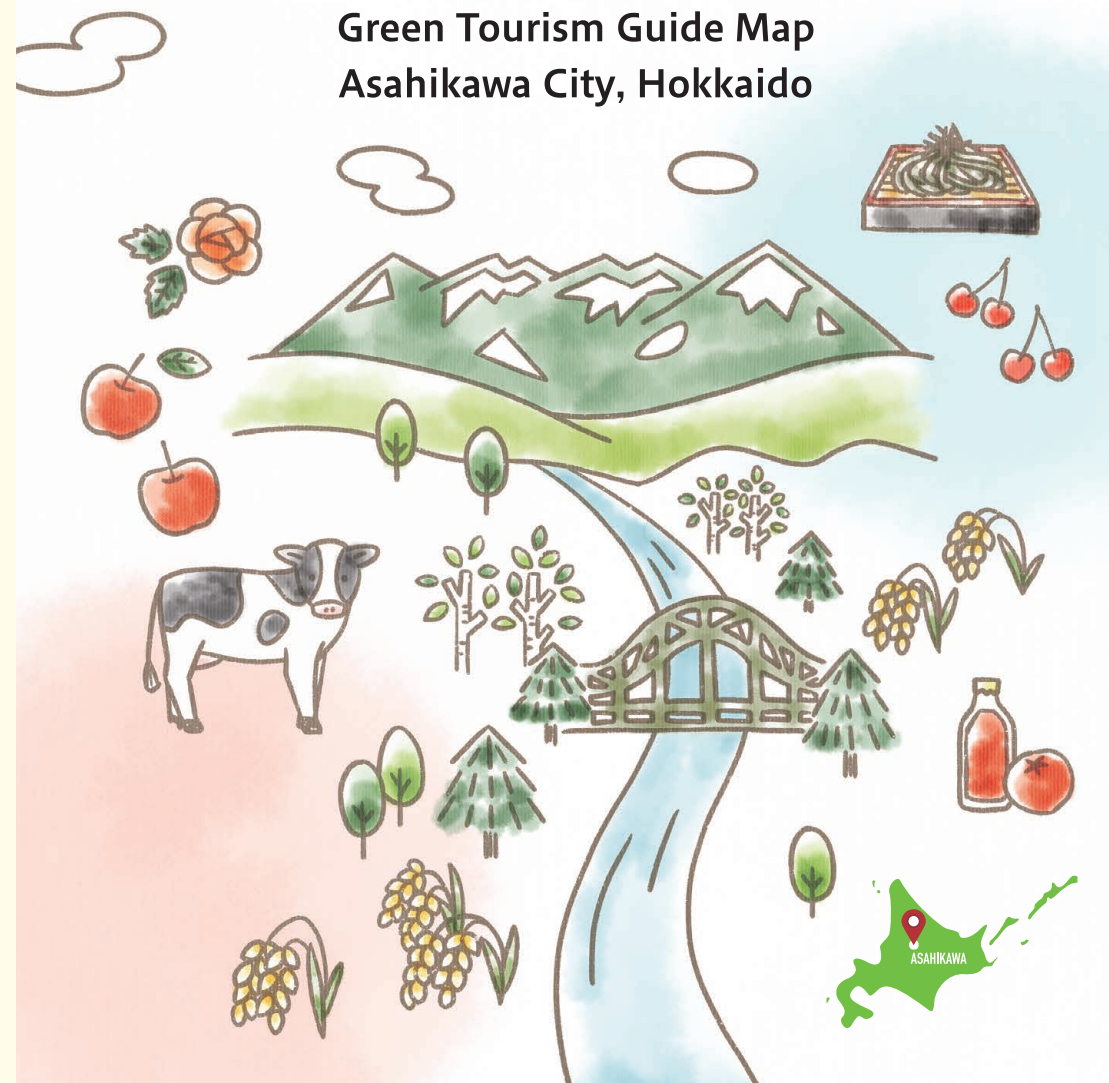

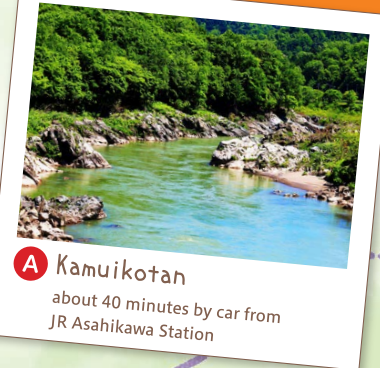

What kind of city is Asahikawa?



Asahikawa is located in the Kamikawa region of Hokkaido in almost the exact middle of the island. The city is surrounded by the Daisetsuzan (also called Taisetsuzan) mountains and green farmlands spread in the basin where the Ishikari River and many other tributary streams merge. While it functions as the main city of northern Hokkaido, the city also plays an important role as one of the country's biggest food suppliers of products such as rice.

Lowest recorded temperature in Japan (official) -41°C
 Winter is long and cold in Asahikawa. The lowest temperature ever recorded in Japan, -41.0 degrees, was recorded here in 1902. The production of Soba and dairy farming flourishes in the Etambetsu area, where the temperature is particularly low. Specialties include cheese and soba noodles that have a sweet flavor.



Rice made in Asahikawa
 Asahikawa is a city in a basin surrounded by magnificent mountains including the Daisetsuzan (also called Taisetsuzan). The fields are nourished by the great volume of water that flows from the mountains, and the difference in the temperature between nights and days helps promote the growth of the rice. The combination of a blessed environment, farming technology, and the tireless efforts of the farmers allow for the production of high-quality and delicious rice.

The northern limit for cherry and apple cultivation
 Many orchards are in the Kamuicho Kamuikotan, Nishioka, Tomisawa and Higashi Asahikawa regions, which are located in the western area of the city. The notable fruits cultivated in the region include cherries, apples, pears, grapes, Japanese plums, prunes, and blueberries. Asahikawa is regarded as the northern limit for cherry and apple farming.

Around 40 species of vegetables are planted with minimum pesticides and chemical fertilizers. You are free to join weeding in the field at any time. You can make some Japanese-style curry with fresh vegetables from the field. A pine tree which has almost reached the height of the two-storey house is the landmark to look for when you visit us.
