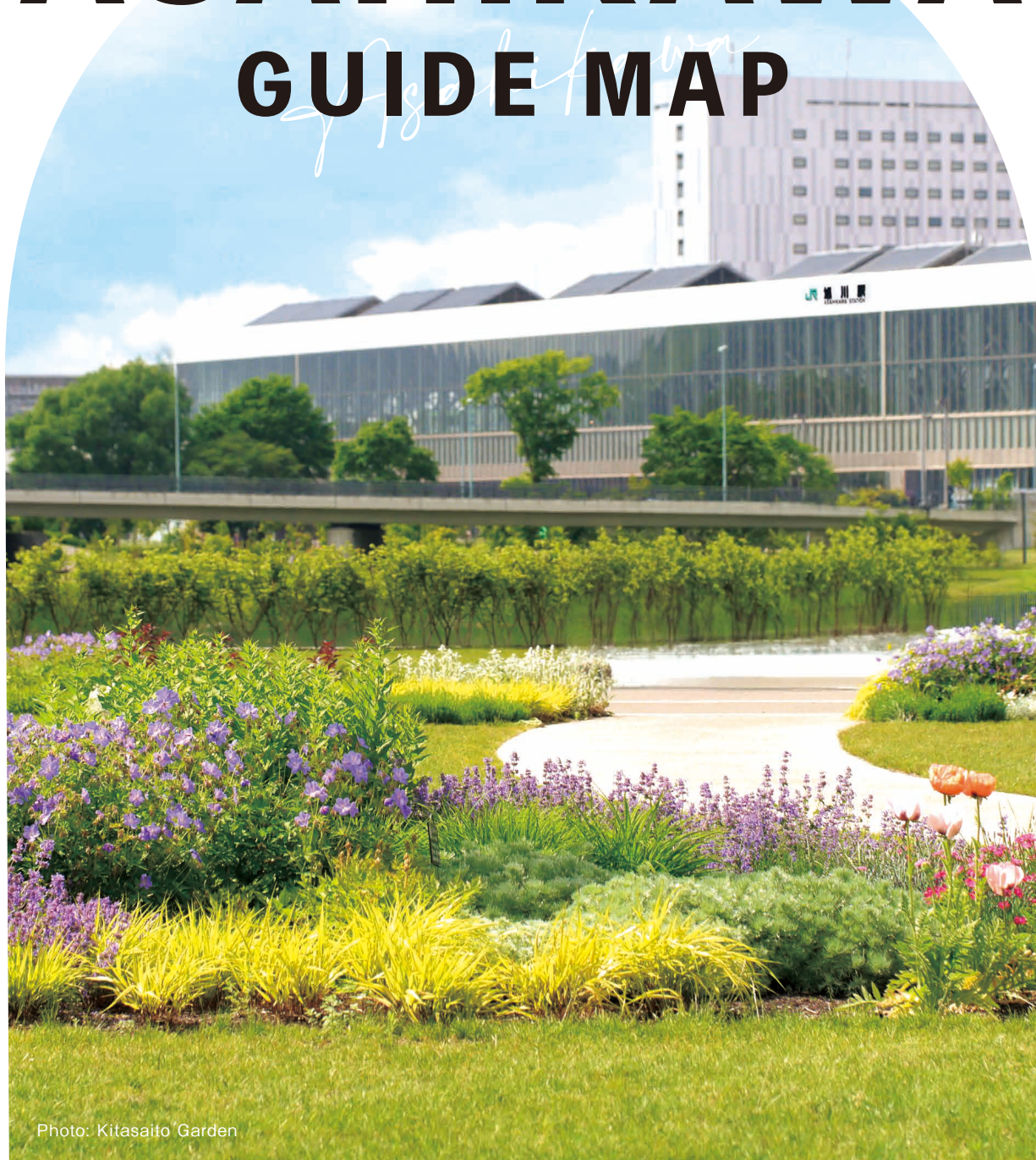

1 KIBANA

Inspired by the diamond dust that glitters in the air on the coldest days of a Hokkaido winter, KIBANA is one of Asahikawa's most famous sweets. Melt-in-your-mouth white chocolate is sandwiched between aromatic almond-flavored gallettes. This delicious confection is a popular souvenir. (Available at: Tsuboya stores, souvenir shops)



7 Kuma-bokko

These wooden bear figurines are a local folk craft. Carved from Yezo spruce and Sakhalin fir, no two figurines are exactly the same. Their charming design is sure to capture your heart. (Available at: Tomiya Kyodo Mingei)



2 Craft Beer

"One glass will leave you feeling happy." That is the aim of Taisetsu Ji Beer, whose craft beers combine smoothness with a color you'll love, an aroma that will bring you pleasure, and a taste that will have you hooked. 3 Yukara-Ori A Hokkaido dyed textile craft

Yukara-ori craftspeople work entirely by hand, dyeing wool, spinning it into threads, and weaving it on a loom to create these uniquely textured textiles. The patterns are inspired by Hokkaido's abundant nature, and have a cozy look that will make you want to take some home. (Available at: Yukaraori Kobo)



4 Asahikawa Hand Towels

Kondo Co., Ltd., a legendary Asahikawa craft textile dyeing factory with a history of over 100 years, has begun producing Asahikawa hand towels. Covered with Asahikawa-themed illustrations by Michiko Abe from Yotsubasha, these hand towels are a great way to remember your visit. The distinctive juniper berry fragrance of gin is combined with the cedar cask scent that can only come from a sake brewery and complemented by a refreshing citrus tang. This curry is made with Asahi Takasago beef, from cows raised on sake lees from Takasago Shuzo, renowned for its Kokushi Muso sake. Enjoy the tender meat, sweet fat, and perfect blend of spices. (Available at: Hokumin, Ekinaka Asahikawa Tourism and Local Products Information Center)

Asahikawa Station (Bike Rental)

Your first stop is the Asahikawa Tourism and Local Products Information Center in Asahikawa Station, an easy place to pick up a rental bike from spring to fall. A bike tour is the perfect way to explore the city and the great outdoors.



Kitasaito Garden

Few gardens in Japan are as centrally located as Kitasaito Garden: it's right next to Asahikawa Station. It's the perfect place to stop for a rest, and the view of the river and the Daisetsuzan mountains will give you a new appreciation of the beautiful nature of this city.



OTOKOYAMA SAKE PARK

Fun for the whole family! Learn about Otokoyama's history and Japan's sake brewing culture in the museum, stop off at the shop and enjoy coffee, Calpico, and shaved ice made with brewing water in addition to the brewery's sake, and take the kids to Ochoko Square to play on the slide shaped like a sake bottle.

A furniture and craft shop with permanent booths from around 30 local producers of furniture and crafts.



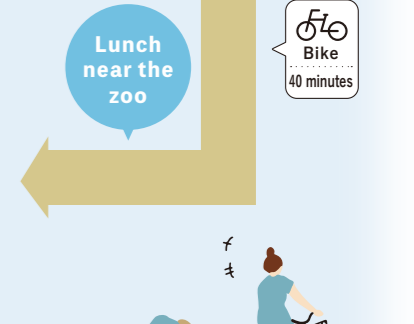
Rice Field Art

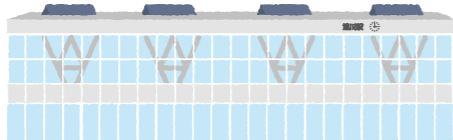
Yukinowa Asahikawa (Illumination on Kaimono Koen)

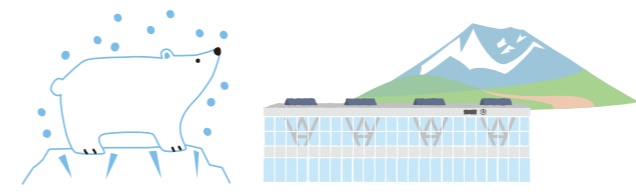

History of Asahikawa



History of Asahikawa
The indigenous Ainu people have lived in the Kamikawa area, where Asahikawa is located, since ancient times. The region as we know it today began with the establishment of Asahikawa Village, Kamui Village, and Nagayama Village in 1890. There are theories that the characters of "Asahikawa" are based on cup-pet, which means "river where the sun rises" in Ainu. Asahikawa was rapidly developed as a military city through development activities by Tondenhei and the relocation of the 7th Division of the former Army in 1901. After being designated as a city in 1922, Asahikawa flourished as a logistics hub. To this day, it is northern Hokkaido's core city and a major commercial, industrial, and lumbering center.

The Eight Views of Asahikawa

To protect, nurture and spread awareness about its beautiful nature, Asahikawa has chosen the eight best views in the city with suggestions from locals. These places offer a wide range of stunning natural beauty – undulating land, rushing rivers, trees swaying in the breeze, new greenery and natural phenomena formed over centuries.

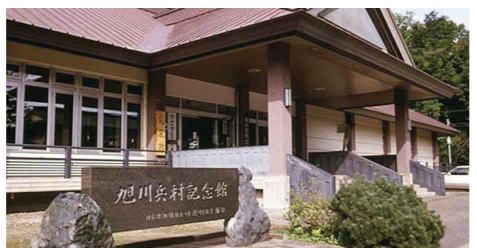
Learn about Ainu history and culture from exhibits that present artifacts in an easy-to-understand way. There is no better place to get a general understanding of Asahikawa's history and nature.

Asahikawa is the birthplace of the iconic Japanese writer, Yasushi Inoue. This exhibition encompasses his 83 years of life, comprising a collection of precious documents, Inoue's original study and drawing room (relocated to Asahikawa from his home in Tokyo), and his hand-written notebooks where he poured out his feelings for his birthplace.

This museum's exhibition centers on 12 pieces of art by Nakahara Teijiro, one of the most influential sculptors in Japan's modern art scene. It's hard to believe that the building, now appointed as a National Important Cultural Property, was originally established in 1902 as a watering hole for military officers.

11 Asahibashi Bridge

This bridge connecting the north and south side of the city was built in 1932, using the most cutting-edge technology available at the time. To this very day, its elegant, arched shape makes it an unmistakable and beloved symbol of the city for many of its inhabitants.

Once a sacred place for the Ainu people, who called it "Chinomishiri" ("the mountain on which we pray"), this mountain was renamed as "Arashiyama" during the late 19th century due to its striking resemblance to a famous mountain with the same name in Kyoto. Inside the park you can visit Hoppo Yasoen, a botanic garden with a vast collection of native plants from northern regions.



14 Heiwa-dori Kaimono Koen

Built in 1972, Heiwa-dori Kaimono Koen was the first permanent pedestrian street to be built in Japan. The tree-lined avenue extends about one kilometer from the north side of Asahikawa Station, surrounded by sculptures, boutiques and cafes. Events are held here throughout the year.

Kamuy Kotan is without a doubt one of the most beautiful scenic spots in the city. The multifaceted beauty of this gorge changes with the seasons: it is resplendent with cherry blossoms in the spring, greenery in the summer and colorful leaves in fall, then in winter it is covered with glittering snow.

 Ayako Miura was the author of many literary masterpieces such as "Hyouten" (Freezing Point), "Shiokari Touge" (Shiokari Pass), and "Juuoku" (Gun Point), all dealing with the question of "how people survive". The museum stands at the entrance to the Foreign Tree Specimen Forest, where Hyouten (Freezing Point) was set, so that you can soak up the atmosphere of the book. There is a café in the museum.

The museum's collection displays Ainu utensils used in everyday life, various documents of historical relevance, and even a traditional dwelling called "cise".

 Hokkaido's only poetry museum, dedicated to Tetsuro Nishikawa, a prominent figure in Japan's poetry world. He wrote many of his poems while strolling along the banks of the Ishikari River and 7-jo Ryoku-do (Green Street). In 2014, he won the Special Prize at the Seventh Japanese One Line Poetry Award. On 7-jo Ryoku-do, outside the museum you'll see a beautiful Hidaka limestone literature monument dedicated to Nishikawa and author Seichi Morimura, called The Green Street of Youth.
