Please consult with the collection company for more information. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You do not need to separate aluminum and steel cans. • Please empty out the contents of the can and rinse. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Limited to plastic bottles used by employees, etc. for personal consumption. • Please empty out the contents of the can and rinse. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Limited to plastic packaging and containers used by employees, etc. for personal consumption. (Please dispose of work-related garbage as industrial waste) • Empty out all of the food contents, and rinse until clean. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please strain liquids out from kitchen waste. • Please do not throw away thick bones, branches, or frozen goods. • Waste oil counts as industrial waste. • Let's try to recycle as much recyclable paper as we can. • Please remove plastic packaging and vinyl materials from products like individually wrapped food items. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please separate industrial waste properly. Please reference the different categories on the right side of this chart. • Limited to non-burnable waste used by employees, etc. for personal consumption. • Please put large amounts of items (lighters, etc.) in a separate bag.
